Personal Property – Business Closed

Please note that there is no provision in MA Personal Property Tax Law for prorating the personal property tax. If a business has taxable personal property assets in place on the assessment date (1/1) for a given Fiscal Year, the business owes the personal property tax for the entire fiscal year.

Example: Fiscal Year 2023 runs 7/1/2022 – 6/30/2023. The Assessment Date for Fiscal Year 2023 is 1/1/2022. A business closes on 1/15/2022 (14 days after the 1/1/2022 Assessment Date for Fiscal Year 2023). The business is responsible for paying all personal property tax bills issued for Fiscal Year 2023 (7/1/2022-6/30/2023).
