

Chapter 185-26. Obstruction of view on corner lots.

On any corner lot within twenty-five (25') feet of any street intersection and a distance of twenty (20') feet back from the street line, no solid wall (including a retaining wall), fence or structure and no hedges, shrubs or other plant growth shall be permitted in excess of three (3') feet above the crown of the road, if it blocks more than one-third ($1/3$) of the area up to three (3') feet at the time of the greatest foliage. Trees may be planted in the same area, no closer than five (5') feet apart, so long as the lowest branches are not closer than eight (8') feet to the ground. In addition, slopes on any corner lot shall be no greater than three to one, three (3') feet horizontal to one (1') foot vertical above the street line (right of way) in the same area.
