4. Beaver Street Interceptor (BSI) Replacement Update

- a. Town Council will be presented with a financing plan for the project in early January. Main drivers of the need for the project include but not limited to access challenges, severely outdated, and if failure occurs would create a significant financial burden.
- b. Three alternatives are being evaluated as a solution:
 - i. Alternative 1 Rehabilitation of Existing BSI (est. \$9M)
 - ii. Alternative 2 BSI Replacement (est. \$13M)
 - iii. Alternative 3 Rehabilitation and Realignment of BSI (est. \$25M)
- c. Alternative 3 is most advantageous and addresses reliability of operations, risk of overflows, and environmental concerns to a greater degree than Alternative 1 and Alternative 2.
