2. History of the Oliver Pond House. We plan to add Jim Johnston to our speaker list for 2017.
3. National Register signs for the downtown - a good idea, in progress.
4. Application for Franklin Cultural Council grant is pending. This would allow us to purchase an iC4K display panel created by Almont Green. We'll know the outcome in January. We've already accrued \$125. from the open house at Almont Green Studios in 2016 towards this acquisition.
5. Museum Website - eagle scout project (Sal B.) - The plan is for him to create a new website from scratch, to supervise other scouts in this effort, and to preserve the current contents of the site. They also plan to scan WWII veterans pictures taken by Stanley Chilson, and to create a corresponding user input tool to add peoples' comments about them.
6. Shelving for upstairs room (Remy) - In progress.
7. Amending the town's demolition delay bylaw - Nothing new. Mary will ask Gus Brown about a possible expiration (1 year) of the Commission's assent to demolitions.
8. Reprinting William M. Thayer's books - Nothing new.

9. Obtaining a copy of 1970s Harvard student (Steven M. Diamond) thesis on the Town of Franklin. Nothing new.
10. Native American Corner - much progress, some final touches ahead.
