- Waiting List We currently have 11,224 applicants waiting to be housed in Franklin. 216 are local applicants.
- Rent Roll review
- Vacancies Congregate has 1 vacancy, 667 has 3 vacant units and we have 3 family units vacant. We are experiencing a lot of applicants that do not respond to our mailings. The last list pull of 100 applicants only resulted in 3 responses. The amount of time and expense involved in managing the CHAMP waiting list is

extreme. Carole is outstanding at working the CHAMP system and following the regulation but lack of adequate response from the applicant is overwhelming. We leased 2 units in October. One to a non-local and the other was a transfer.

The tenant who posted extensive negative comments and lies on Facebook neglected to notify their following of the restoration of heat.

- Motion to add 'Summer Street' to the agenda by Chairman Danello, second by Commissioner Brunelli. All in favor. So voted. Chairman Danello brought the Members up to date on the progress to obtain ownership of a property on Summer Street. Discussion took place referencing the need of well and septic inspection.
