Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Ch. 131, s.40 (The Wetlands Act) Franklin Conservation Commission will hold a Remote Public Hearing on Thursday, September 17, 2020 at 7:04 PM on a Notice of Intent filed by Carla Moynihan, Esq. on behalf of PharmaCannis Massachusetts, Inc. for the construction of a 4,150 s.f. commercial building with associated amenities within the 100 ft. buffer zone to bordering vegetated wetlands and impacting isolated vegetated wetlands.

The project is located at 164 and 166 Grove Street, Parcel IDs: 306-004-000 and 306-005-000
