Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Ch. 131, s.40 (The Wetlands Act) Franklin Conservation Commission will hold a Remote Public Hearing on Thursday, May 28, 2020 at 7:00 PM on a Notice of Intent filed by Marcus Partners, Inc. of Boston, MA for construction of a new industrial building and associated parking in the buffer zone to bordering vegetated wetlands and isolated vegetated wetlands.
