Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Ch. 131, s.40 (The Wetlands Protection Act) Franklin Conservation Commission will hold a Hybrid Public Hearing on Thursday, May 4, 2023 at 7:06 PM on a Notice of Intent filed by Karon Skinner Catrone, Stoughton, MA on behalf of Robert and Anne Valluzzi, Franklin, MA. This NOI is an after-the-fact filing for an above ground pool, slope stabilization, retaining wall construction, and dry well within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to BVW; with a portion of the work proposed within the 25-foot "No Disturbance" Zone.

The Project is located at 2 Elm Street, Map 219 Lot 21, in the Rural Residential II Zone.

The hearing will provide an open forum for the discussion. This meeting will be done remotely via the "ZOOM" platform and "In-person" in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building, 355 East Central Street. Residents can visit the Town Website (Franklinma.gov) and click on the Town Calendar for up to date information on how to access the meeting.

All records and files for this project can be viewed at the Conservation Office located on the first floor of the Franklin Municipal Building.

Any person or organization so wishing will be afforded an opportunity to be heard. The hearing location is accessible to persons with physical disabilities.
