In accordance with the Town of Franklin Zoning By-Laws, the Franklin Planning Board will hold a public hearing on **Monday**, **January 7**, **2019 at 7:05 PM** in the Town Council Chambers of the Franklin Municipal Building, 355 East Central Street, for a Special Permit and Site Plan application titled "Highland Village, 278 – 300 West Central Street" prepared by Guerriere & Halnon, Franklin, MA, dated November 20, 2018 and submitted to the Department of Planning & Community Development on November 28, 2018, by Joel D'Errico, 72 Deer View Way, Franklin, MA 02038.
