Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Ch. 131, s.40 (The Wetlands Act) Franklin Conservation Commission will hold a Hybrid Public Hearing on Thursday, February 17, 2022 at 7:01 PM on a Notice of Intent filed by David & Monica Mann, Franklin, MA for the construction of a an addition to the rear of the house, a shed, two new retaining walls and an additional patio within the 100-foot buffer zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands.

The project is located at 41 Dover Circle, Map 227 Parcel 1, in the Rural Residential 2 Zone.

The hearing will provide an open forum for the discussion. This meeting will be done remotely via the "ZOOM" platform and "In-person" in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building, 355 East Central Street.
