Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Ch. 131, s.40 (The Wetlands Act) Franklin Conservation Commission will hold a Hybrid Public Hearing on Thursday, October 21, 2021 at 7:02 PM on a Notice of Intent filed by Paul Pomarico, Franklin, MA for after-the-fact and newly proposed removal of trees within the Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetative Wetlands at a single-family house lot, along with stumping of previously cut trees and associated grading.

The project is located at 455 Maple Street, Map 242, Lot 016.

The hearing will provide an open forum for the discussion. This meeting will be done remotely via the "ZOOM" platform and "In-person" in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building, 355 East Central Street.
