## Town of Franklin Conservation Commission

Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Ch. 131, s.40 (The Wetlands Protection Act) Franklin Conservation Commission will hold a Hybrid Public Hearing on Thursday, December 1, 2022 at 7:04 PM on a Notice of Intent filed by Arthur Borden, PLS of Arthur F. Borden & Associates Inc. on behalf of Paata Macharashvili of Washington 803 Nominee Trust, Stoughton MA. The project proposes the demolition of an existing structure followed by the construction of a new single family house, foundation, and driveway totaling approximately 6,420 square feet within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands (BVW), of which 1,050 square feet of work is proposed within the 50-foot Buffer Zone to BVW.

The Project is located at 803 Washington Street, Map 322 Parcel 61, in the Rural Residential 1 Zone.

The hearing will provide an open forum for the discussion. This meeting will be done remotely via the "ZOOM" platform and "In-person" in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building, 355 East Central Street.
