Town of Franklin Conservation Commission

Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Ch. 131, s.40 (The Wetlands Act) Franklin Conservation Commission will hold a Hybrid Public Hearing on Thursday, April 14, 2022 at 7:02 PM on a Notice of Intent filed by Nick Dewhurst of Bohler on behalf of TMC Holdings & Development 2, LLC in Bellingham, MA for the construction of a 42,750+ square foot multi-tenant industrial building with associated parking, landscaping, utilities and stormwater management components within 100 feet of a Bordering Vegetated Wetland.

The project is located at 839 Upper Union Street, Map 314 Parcel 1, in the Industrial Zone.

The hearing will provide an open forum for the discussion. This meeting will be done remotely via the "ZOOM" platform and "In-person" in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building, 355 East Central Street. Residents can visit the Town Website (Franklinma.gov) and click on the Town Calendar for up to date information on how to access the meeting.

All records and files for this project can be viewed at the Conservation Office located on the first floor of the Franklin Municipal Building.

Any person or organization so wishing will be afforded an opportunity to be heard. The hearing location is accessible to persons with physical disabilities.
