Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Ch. 131, s.40 (The Wetlands Act) Franklin Conservation Commission will hold a Hybrid Public Hearing on Thursday, January 6, 2021 at 7:01 PM on a Revised Notice of Intent filed by Peter Genta, Franklin Flex Space LLC, Wellesley, MA for the construction of three buildings with an access driveway, parking area, three storm-water systems, utility installation, grading and landscaping within the buffer zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands, and within Bordering Land Subject to Flooding.

The project is located on Washington Street – Map 304, Lot 064 and 064-001.

The hearing will provide an open forum for the discussion. This meeting will be done remotely via the “ZOOM” platform and “In-person” in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building, 355 East Central Street.
