FRANKLIN PLANNING BOARD PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

In accordance with the Town of Franklin Zoning By-Laws, the Franklin Planning Board will hold a public hearing at the Town Hall (and can also be attended remotely) on **Monday, November 15, 2021 at 7:05 PM** in the Town Council Chambers of the Franklin Municipal Building, 355 East Central Street, for a Scenic Road application for the cutting or removal of trees on Spring Street, prepared by National Grid Forestry, Hopedale MA.

The proposed road improvements will include replacing poles and wires along Spring St to provide power to the nearby solar farm. Dead and declining trees will also be removed to provide proper clearance and improve safety and reliability.

Please note: This will be your only written notice of this public hearing. Should the Planning Board vote to continue this Public Hearing, the date and time will be posted on the Planning Board's website under Agendas.
