- a) The rebate is \$50 per toilet, limit to two per household.
- b) Applicant is responsible for verifying that the new toilet is an EPA WaterSense labeled high-efficiency toilet.
- c) An unaltered dated sales receipt, listing the make and model numbers, must accompany this application.
- d) Rebates are available to residential Franklin Water Department (FWD) account holders. Applicant must be the owner of the property listed on the rebate application.
- e) Rebate offer is on a first-come, first-served basis until funding is exhausted. Toilet(s) must be purchased on or after June 1, 2016. Applications must be received within 90 days of purchase. The new toilet must be installed.
- f) Old toilets cannot be reused. The applicant will be issued a voucher to dispose of the used toilets at the Franklin Recycling Center free of charge.
- g) Applicant agrees and understands that the program may be discontinued and/or the rebate dollar amounts may be changed by the FWD or by the exhaustion of program funding, without further notification to customers possessing outstanding applications.

- h) New construction projects do not qualify for rebates.
- i) In order to be eligible to participate in the rebate program, applicants must have an account in good standing with the FWD and agree that the FWD or its representative has the right to inspect the installation of the fixture before or after the rebate is awarded.
- j) Applicant agrees and understands that the Franklin Water Department does not guarantee that the installation of a high efficiency toilet will result in water savings, as site-specific water consumption varies.
- k) The Franklin Water Department does not warrant, endorse, or assume liability for the quality, performance, or safety of the contractor and/or retailer or wholesaler, or performance of any appliance or fixture.
