

# FAQs

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## **What happens when a title expires?**

The titles will automatically return themselves, so no action is needed on your part.

## **What if I don't finish my book?**

The app will remember your place in the book, so simply follow the steps to re-check out the title and resume reading.

## **Can I renew a book?**

If no other patrons have placed a hold on the title you may visit your account page in the app to renew the title two days before it expires. You will need to re-download the title as a new check out.

## **What formats can I use with the OverDrive app?**

You can use OverDrive for ePub, Open ePub, and MP3.

## **Does OverDrive keep track of what I've checked out?**

The History section in the upper left menu lists your most recent checked out titles.

## **Can I borrow a Kindle ebook?**

To read a Kindle book you will have to use the Kindle app and download through your Amazon.com account. For more information please ask a librarian about this process.

## **Can OverDrive connect with my social media accounts?**

The Settings section in the menu allows you to link your Facebook, Twitter, or Goodreads accounts with your OverDrive account.

# install OverDrive app

These instructions are for any Apple mobile device running iOS 6 and newer.



In the **App Store**, search for the OverDrive app.

Tap **Get**, then **Install**. You will need your Apple ID and password to install.

Register for an **OverDrive account** if you don't already have one.

You can use your Facebook account to sign up too.

Swipe left to right to open your app menu.

Find the **My Libraries** list at the top of your menu.

Tap **Add a library**.



Search for the Franklin **Public Library** by name or zip code.

If you are a resident in more than one library system, you may add additional libraries here also.

Search for Franklin and select **Franklin Public Library** from list.



Click **Minuteman Library Network** to start finding books.

# check out & read

**Sign in** to your Franklin Public Library account using your library card number and PIN.



To search for a title, browse by category or use **Search**.

**Advanced Search** lets you narrow your search even further.

A black book or headphone icon means the title is available, and a gray icon means it is unavailable.

Click **Borrow** to check out an available book, or **Place a Hold** for an unavailable title.



Tap **Go to Bookshelf** to begin the downloading process.

Tap **Download** and the title will be sent to your app.

All downloaded titles are in the **Bookshelf** space in your app. Tap the cover of the title to enjoy your book.



If you need to adjust settings or return to your **Bookshelf** while reading, tap the middle of the screen to access menus.

You can return a book early by pressing and holding a book cover until a menu opens with the **Return** option.
