The applicant hereby certifies that all soil erosion and sediment control measures are designed in accordance with current Massachusetts Erosion and Sediment Control Guidelines for Urban and Suburban Areas and the Town of Franklin's Best Development Practice Guidelines and will be installed in accordance with those guidelines and the plan as approved by the Town of Franklin Department of Public Works (DPW) and Town Bylaw Chapter 153, §1-18 and agrees as follows:

1. To notify the DPW in writing at least 48 hours in advance of any land disturbance activity.
2. To notify the DPW upon final stabilization of the Project.
3. To maintain a copy of the certified Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Plan on the project site during construction.
4. To allow DPW agents to go upon project lands for inspection.
5. That any conveyance of this project or portion thereof prior to its completing will transfer full responsibility for compliance with the certified plan to any subsequent owners.
6. To comply with all terms and conditions of this application and certified plan including payment of all fees prescribed by the fee schedule hereby incorporated by reference.

\*\*Engineering related items of the Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Plan **MUST** be prepared by or under the direction of and sealed by a Professional Engineer or Architect licensed by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Requirement for a P.E. or Architect may be waived for individual single family house lots.

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The applicant hereby acknowledges that structural measures contained in the Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Plan are reviewed for adequacy to reduce off site soil erosion and sedimentation and not for adequacy of structural design. The applicant shall retain full responsibility for any damage which may result from any construction activity notwithstanding DPW certification of the subject soil erosion and sediment control plan. It is understood that approval of the plan submitted with this application shall be valid only for the duration of the initial project approval granted by the Town of Franklin. All municipal renewals of this project will require submission and approval by the DPW. In no case shall the approval extend beyond three and one half years at which time resubmission and certification will be required. Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Plan certification is limited to the controls specified in the plan. It is not authorized to engage in the proposed land use unless such use has been previously approved by the Town of Franklin.
