

Franklin MASSACHUSETTS

The Roadway Moratorium Map displays all town roads in Franklin that have undergone a total road reconstruction within the last five years. The moratorium prohibits street-excavations on these roads for 5 full years after the year of construction. For example, a roadway that was reconstructed in 2019 cannot be cut into until after the 2024 construction season. This information will be updated on a yearly basis.
