Site Plan Review Comments from June 3rd Planning Board Meeting

Mr. Rondeau,

We are writing in response to the Board's request to provide additional information regarding the construction traffic associated with the new Tri-County Regional Vocational Technical High School project. A new access road is being built as part of the project stretching from Tri-County School Drive up through the wooded area along the power lines, extending to the construction site behind the existing high school. The intent is for construction traffic only (workers and deliveries) to utilize this road to travel to and from the project site, minimizing disruptions to the current entrance roads used by the high school students and staff. The typical work hours for the project will be 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM on Monday through Friday, with most workers arriving to the jobsite before 7:00 AM, prior to the bulk of students and staff arriving at the existing high school, and will leave the jobsite after 3:00 PM, when most students and staff have typically already left for the day. Deliveries to the jobsite will be restricted from 7:00 AM – 8:00 AM, and again from 2:00 PM – 3:00 PM, minimizing interference with student and staff drop-off/pickup times. The construction is scheduled to last from the summer of 2024 to the fall of 2028, with the number of workers on site fluctuating from 10 – 35 at the early stages, gradually increasing as construction progresses to a peak of approximately 180 – 200 during the busiest period from summer of 2026 to summer of 2027, then gradually decreasing until late stages when there will be approximately 10 – 20 workers on site.
