Remember, nothing terminates a program faster than waiting until the last minute to register. Sign up early to avoid disappointment.

REFUND POLICY

Refunds are only issued in the event of a cancelled program or if there is a medical emergency with a doctor's note. 

REGISTRATION, FIELD TRIPS, LIT

This will include an interview process, \$100.00 fee and we will choose a limited number of candidates. If your 15 & 16 year old is interested, please contact us as space is limited.
2. Our policy requires all campers to be registered by the Friday **BEFORE** camp starts. Registration/ payment will **NOT** be accepted onsite at King Street under any circumstances. Registration will not be open during the weekend, so please be sure to register your child early.

Leader in Training Internship Program- What is it?

This program is an opportunity to spend a summer with our highly trained and enthusiastic staff. Candidates will develop self-awareness, build conflict resolution skills, and identify and address personal challenges. This does not guarantee a counselor position in future summers; however it does offer an opportunity to show off your skills and desire to be in the running for a counselor position post LIT Internship Program.

How do I go about becoming an LIT?

All interested candidates must participate in an interview process with the Director of Recreation and the Camp Director. We will call to schedule your interview in early April.

Who are we looking for?

What is expected of you?
