NOTIFICATION TO ABUTTERS

Under the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act And The Franklin Wetlands Protection Bylaw

In accordance with the second paragraph of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 131, Section 40, you are hereby notified of the following proposed project:

TAG Central LLC has filed a Notice of Intent with the Franklin Conservation Commission for construction of a 40B multifamily development on historic nursery/landscape yard property totaling 264 units, including associated parking, stormwater management, habitat enhancement/invasive species management and wetland replication, partially within Riverfront Area, Bordering Land Subject to Flooding, Isolated Vegetated Wetlands, and the 100-ft buffer zone, on 4/17/2025, under the Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L c.131 §40).

Notice of the public hearing including the date, time, and place will be posted in the Franklin Town Hall at least forty eight (48) hours in advance of the public hearing.

The public hearing will be held on Thursday, May 1, 2025, at 7 pm, via Zoom, and can be accessed through the Conservation Commission agenda for that night, which will be posted on the Town's website 48 hours prior to the meeting.
