

Facts About Marijuana



Marijuana is now legal for adult recreational use in Massachusetts. Only individuals 21 years and older are permitted to buy and/or use marijuana products.



You cannot use marijuana in any form (smoking, vaping, eating or otherwise) in public or on federal land.



You can have up to 1 oz on you and up to 10 oz in your home. You can grow up to 6 plants in your home, and up to 12 plants in a home containing two (2) or more adults.



If you have more than 1 oz of marijuana in your home it is to be locked up. In fact, it is best to keep any amount locked away to keep kids and pets safe. Make sure to leave products in their childproof packaging.



You cannot have an open container of any form of marijuana in the passenger area of your car while on the road or at a place where the public has access. It must be stored in a closed container in your trunk or in a locked glove compartment.



It is illegal to drive under the influence of marijuana. Instead, use public transportation, ride-shares, or catch a ride with a sober friend.



You cannot drive with cannabis across state lines, bring it on a plane, or mail it, even to states and countries where it is legal.
