

Civil War Soldiers Monument

Franklin, Massachusetts



Carved from one piece of blue Westerly, RI granite, the 21-foot tall monument was erected in 1903 and is our town's oldest war monument. It pays homage to the 134 Franklin men who fought in the Civil War. The granite base is inscribed with the names of the major Civil War battles in which Franklin men fought. A copper time capsule placed in the base of the monument contains Franklin memorabilia.
