WALL STREET DEVELOPMENT CORP. has filed a Notice of Intent with the Franklin Conservation Commission for the **CONSTRUCTION OF AN ACCESS DRIVE, INCLUDING THE INSTALLATION OF UTILITIES AND SITE GRADING, OFF PROSPECT STREET (Assessor Map 308, Parcel 084)**, under the Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L c.131 §40).
