- 3. FY22 Town Administrator Operating Budget Hearing Continued
  - a. Education
    - Town Schools Franklin Public School District \$67,914,184 (increase of \$2,255,684 from FY21)
      - Enrollment down 2% likely as a result of families with young children not enrolling in K and 1. Enrollment is expected to stay flat at the elementary level. However, Middle and High School enrollment is expected to decrease.
      - Internet upgrades to support remote learning. Majority of increase is to support a 10GB line of service and a cyber security position. Some remote aspects will continue. Not anticipating a large remote program. Anticipating the state not to allow this in the future unless serious medical circumstances.
      - 3. Adding additional staff for curriculum. Historically have had one individual however, there is a need for additional personnel. Initiatives in math at the elementary level due to gaps being raised as part of the pandemic.
      - 4. Redistricting consultant is accounted for in the budget as part of the continuation of the facilities study.
    - ii. Tri-County Regional School \$2,449,637 (decrease of \$54,906 from FY21)
    - iii. Norfolk Aggie \$37,250 (decrease of \$10,000 from FY21)
