2) NEW BUSINESS

Tune It Out program update

Director Liberty updated the board on the Tune it Out Program which now has ten veterans and two instructors. Director Liberty stated that the program has plenty of donated guitars, received a \$100 dollar donation that will be used toward T-Shirts for the veterans of the program and that the Franklin Elks donated \$200. Director Liberty stated they could still use donations and are looking to provide each veteran of the program with their own guitar.

Director Liberty updated the board on hiring a Public Health Nurse who has been hired and will start on September 20, 2021.

Chair Sweet discussed the topic of the Heart Safe Community Program suggesting that Franklin become a member of the program.

Chair Sweet spoke in regards to the School Committee Interaction meeting, specifically regarding wearing masks in school. Chair Sweet stated it is not a "one size fits all" and that things can change depending on what happens with the state decision on October 1, 2021.
