## 6/25/2023

#### Disturbance Cottage Street

On Sunday, 6/25/2023, at approximately 12:45 am Officers were dispatched to a residence on Cottage Street for a reported loud party where people were screaming at each other. All parties left prior to police arrival and no services were requested.
