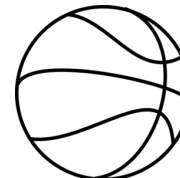

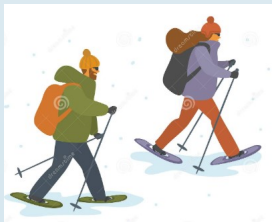

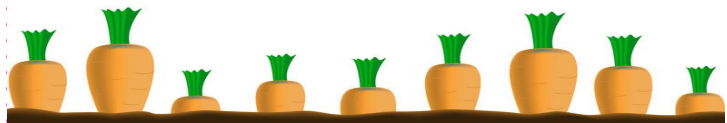


## **COMMUNITY GARDEN**
