Stickers attached to windshield – no exceptions

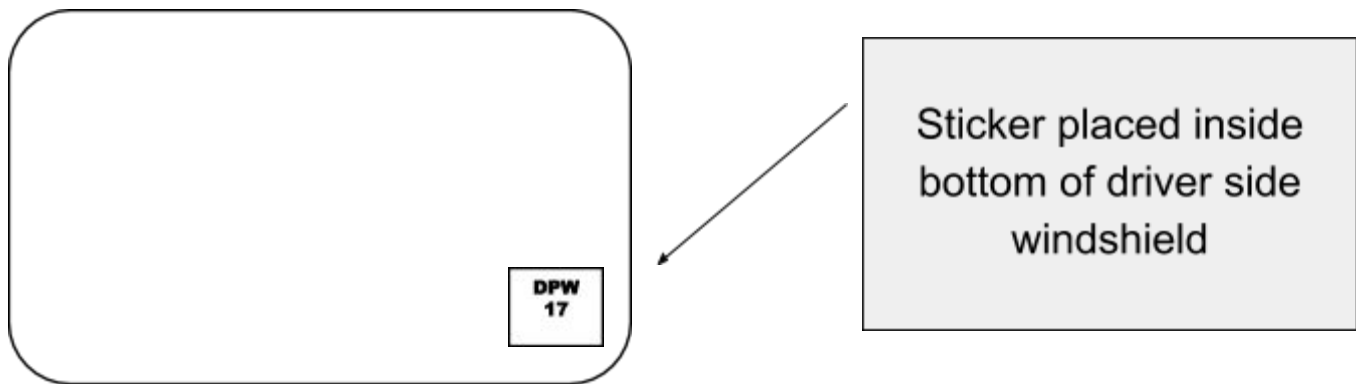
## Hours of Operation

### **Sec. 151-35. Regulations of use**

Use of the recycling center maintained and/or operated by the town or by a contractor under contract with the town to do the same, by other than town employees acting within the scope of their employment, shall be limited to residents of the town, and to such other persons as may establish to the satisfaction of the Director that they are engaged in business activities within the town which require the depositing of recyclable materials from such operations. All such use shall be upon permission of and in accordance with the rules of the Director. No person shall dispose of any trash or deposit any recyclable materials originating outside the limits of the town at the recycling center. No person shall dump trash or fee based items without payment to the attendant.

- a) The fine for each violation of this provision is \$300. The Director or his designee shall be authorized to enforce these provisions.
- b) All persons except town employees acting within the scope of their employment, using the recycling center shall do so at their own risk.

**Selling your car? Scrape off Recycling Center current sticker and bring to DPW office at 257 Fisher St. for a replacement.**

**PROHIBITED ITEMS include:** Any trash, furniture, soil, fill, construction debris, pallets, PVC pipe, Vinyl products including pools, siding, plastic sheets, tarps, food waste, and plastic bags. If you have an item that is not listed on the acceptable item list, do not bring it to the Recycling Center.

## What you should take to the Center

**Asphalt, Bricks, Concrete** - Clean asphalt, bricks and concrete are accepted in small loads (up to a pickup truck at a time).

**American Flags** - Torn, worn or any American flags can be brought to the Recycling Center for appropriate processing. There is a 95 gallon cart with yellow lid and labeled for flags.

**Cardboard** – All you can haul, no need to cut, just flatten! No paper in the cardboard compactor.

**Paper, Glass Jars, Bottles + Plastic containers** – Please rinse, labels and lids ok to leave. Only the same items as collected in the curbside recycling program.

**Scrap metal + Appliances** – Hot water heaters, lawn mowers, bikes, scooters, metal furniture (no wood), dig out that rusted metal and bring it down.

**Yard debris** – leaves, grass, brush + branches (please smaller than 6" diameter) – See rates on back. Nothing placed in plastic bags will be allowed

**Computers and Printers** – Towers, desktop, laptop and home printers. Place in computer shed, hard drives are shredded for security

**Oil** – Auto, lawnmower, 2 cycle, cooking, fryollater, power steering and hydraulic fluid, transmission, etc. Empty into the main tank; take your containers with you.

**Automotive coolant** – Empty your clean coolant here in the 55 gallon drums, take your containers.

**Fluorescent and halogen bulbs** – all sizes (including new small compact fluorescent ones), don't tape!

**Mercury products** – Thermometers, thermostats, medical devices give to attendant

**Clothes** – Donations go to help support the Franklin Library

**Styrofoam** – Clean white Styrofoam used in packaging. No plastic, foam rubber, colored Styrofoam.

**Household Hazardous Waste** - Oil based paints, stains, fertilizers – Latex paint in liquid form and in original container from April through October.

**Mattresses, Box Springs** – Clean, Dry **NO FOAM MATTRESS, MUST BE CLOTH BASED**

**Carpeting** – Clean and dry, 4 foot lengths no larger than 24 inches in diameter.
