Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Ch. 131, s.40 (The Wetlands Act) a Public Hearing will be held on Thursday, July 26, 2018, at 7:25 PM in the Council Chambers of the Franklin Municipal Building, 355 East Central Street, Franklin, MA on a Request for Determination filed by Kelsey & Devon London of Franklin, MA to bring in 1.5 yards of loam to even out the torn up ground from shed removal and extend the grass to provide cushioned, even ground in the buffer zone of bordering vegetated wetlands.
