Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Ch. 131, s.40 (The Wetlands Act) Franklin Conservation Commission will hold a Remote Public Hearing on Thursday, February 4, 2021 at 7:00 PM on a Notice of Intent filed by Manoj Gandhi, Franklin Learning RE LLC of Littleton MA, 01460 for the construction of a 2-story day care facility, playground, associated utilities, and parking accommodations within the 100' buffer zone to a Bordering Vegetated Wetland.
