Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Ch. 131, s.40 (The Wetlands Act) Franklin Conservation Commission will hold a Hybrid Public Hearing on Thursday, February 3, 2022 at 7:01 PM on a Notice of Intent filed by Michael Maglio, P.E., Franklin Department of Public Works, Franklin, MA for the construction of a portion of a shared-use path along Grove Street and associated intersection and roadway improvement at the intersection of Grove Street and Washington Street within the 100-foot buffer zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands.

The project is located on Grove Street and Washington Street, Latitude 42.055968 Longitude -71.427835.

The hearing will provide an open forum for the discussion. This meeting will be done remotely via the "ZOOM" platform and "In-person" in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building, 355 East Central Street.
