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





In 2020, the Council decided to look at the ambulance fees annually and adjust as needed. The Council approved ambulance fee increases in 2021 and again in 2023 in order for the Town to be in the mid range when compared to other local hospital communities. Approval of this bylaw will allow us to remain in the middle and maintain market standards.
