Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Ch. 131, s.40 (The Wetlands Act) a Public Hearing will be held on Thursday, July 11, 2019, at 7:20 PM in the Council Chambers of the Franklin Municipal Building, 355 East Central Street, Franklin, MA on a Notice of Intent filed by Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) to construct a pedestrian trail and bicycle tunnel underneath Prospect Street along the Southern New England Trunkline Trail within the buffer zone of bordering vegetated wetlands.

This project is located on Map 323, 324 Lot 040, 012 at Prospect Street.
