Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Ch. 131, s.40 (Wetlands Protection Act), the Franklin Conservation Commission will hold a Hybrid Public Hearing on Thursday, May 2, 2024 at 7:08 PM for a Notice of Intent filed by Amanda Cavaliere of Guerriere & Halnon, Inc., Franklin, MA on behalf of the Town of Franklin Department of Public Works. The project proposes to extend a roadway and construct drainage infrastructure to provide service to the Franklin Ridge Senior Housing development and two additional lots. Approximately 980 square feet (sf) of work is proposed within Isolated Vegetated Wetlands (IVW). Additionally, approximately 17,991 sf of work is proposed within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to IVW, of which approximately 3,188 sf of work is proposed within the 25-foot "No Disturbance" Zone; 5,708 sf within the 25- to 50-foot Buffer Zone; and 9,095 sf within the 50- to 100-foot Buffer Zone.

The Project is located off of Veterans Memorial Drive, Map 259 Parcel 007-002, in the Rural Residential II Zone.

The hearing will provide an open forum for the discussion. This meeting will be done remotely via the "ZOOM" platform and "In-person" in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building, 355 East Central Street. Residents can visit the Town Website (www.franklinma.gov) and click on the Town Calendar for up to date information on how to access the meeting.

All records and files for this project can be viewed at the Conservation Office located on the first floor of the Franklin Municipal Building.
