Good Morning - Please find an interim report from the chief on the parking in the West, Nason, Church, etc area

Jeff / Jamie,

Every Monday & Wednesday from 09/10/18 - 10/10/18, a member of the 11-7 shift collected the registration plates of every vehicle parked on the following streets: West, East, Nason, Church, Walnut and Union (From Nason to W. Central).

The registration plates were queried to determine the owners residential address. We recorded the total number of vehicles, vehicles owned by residents living in the neighborhood, vehicles owned by residents of Franklin who do not live in the immediate neighborhood and out of town residents (see attached Parking Report).

The data show the following trends:

1. The total number of vehicles has declined from an average of 35 (early September) to 26 (early October).
2. Neighborhood resident vehicles represent 30% of the total number of vehicles parking overnight in the area.
3. All vehicles registered to a Franklin residence (both neighborhood and non-neighborhood) represents 48% of the total vehicles parking in the area overnight.
4. Out of town residents has declined from an average of 21 to 12.

Additional information of interest:

1. Most of the vehicles parking overnight have left the area prior to 7:00 AM. I frequently drove through the area on my way to work prior to 7:30 AM and observed a majority of the vehicles had left the area.
2. A vehicle with six (6) unpaid parking citations was identified and towed from West Street recently. The owner will not be able to retrieve the vehicle until they have paid the citations and related towing / storage costs.
3. We have issued 19 Parking Citations in the area from 09/10 - 10/10/18. For most of the period of time in question, only a small area along Church Ave and West Street was marked with the restricted parking. PCO Qunlan did not return to work from maternity leave until 10/01/18.
