

MBTA COMMUTER RAIL POSITIVE TRAIN CONTROL PROGRAM UPDATE

Updated Advisory: Drill Work on Franklin Commuter Rail Line on April 28-29

Work in Walpole, Norfolk, and Stoughton will occur 6AM-6PM

MassDOT and the MBTA are undertaking federally mandated Positive Train Control (PTC) infrastructure installation which will increase the safety of commuter rail customers and would like to advise the community of upcoming daytime drill work within the right-of-way along the MBTA Franklin Commuter Rail Line. <u>Due to the equipment necessary to perform this work, high noise levels can be expected.</u>

On the **Weekend of April 28-29, 2018**, the PTC Systems Integrator Ansaldo STS USA, Inc. is scheduled to perform rock drilling activities during daytime work hours of between approximately 6AM – 6PM.

The work will take place along the Franklin Line between Walpole and Forge Park stations at locations in Walpole, Norfolk, and Franklin.
