### I. SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

- J. LEGISLATION FOR ACTION
  - 1. Resolution 17-20: Chapter 61A, Non-Exercise of First Refusal Option Property located at 4 Mount Street (Motion to Move Resolution 17-20: Majority vote (5))

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council refused the Town's right of first refusal on the property at 4 Mount Street. Approved 8-0 (Recused: Bissanti).

2. Resolution 17-21: Compensation Plan, FY 2018 (Motion to Move Resolution 17-21: Majority vote (5))

<u>ACTION</u>: Ms. Pfeffer MOVED to amend the FY18 Compensation Plan by maintaining FY17 low and mid-range rates of pays for the G1 classification. SECONDED. *Approved 9-0*.

**ACTION:** The Council approved the FY18 Compensation Plan, as amended. *Approved 9-0*.

3. Resolution 17-22: Town Council Approval of the Resubmittal of Zoning Bylaw Amendment 16-755: Zoning Map Changes from Rural Residential 1 to Residential VII of an Area on Summer Street (Motion to Move Resolution 17-22: Majority vote (5))

<u>ACTION</u>: Mr. Vallee MOVED to postpone this agenda item until the June 27<sup>th</sup> Town Council meeting. SECONDED. *Denied 3-5 (Yes: Padula, Kelly, Vallee; No: Dellorco, Jones, Mercer, Pellegri, Pfeffer; Recused: Bissanti*).

<u>ACTION</u>: The Town Council rejected a proposal to approve the resubmittal of zoning bylaw amendment 16-775: a zoning map change on Summer Street. *Rejected 2-6 (Yes: Padula, Kelly; No: Dellorco, Jones, Mercer, Pellegri, Pfeffer, Vallee; Recused: Bissanti).* 

4. Bylaw Amendment 17-787: Amendment to the Code of the Town of Franklin at Chapter 179, Water – 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading (Motion to Move Bylaw Amendment 17-787: Majority Roll Call vote (5))

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council approved the final reading of a bylaw codifying water conservation measures the town has been performing for decades. This bylaw does <u>not</u> include prohibition measures for private wells. *Approved 9-0*.

5. Zoning Bylaw Amendment 17-788: Definitions. Brewery, Distillery, or Winery with Tasting Room – Referral to Planning Board (Motion to Refer Bylaw Amendment 17-788 to the Planning Board (Majority Vote (5))

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council referred the zoning bylaw for craft beer, wine and spirits to the Planning Board. *Approved 9-0*.

6. Bylaw Amendment 17-789: Amendment to Water System Map – 1<sup>st</sup> Reading (Motion to Move Bylaw Amendment 17-789 to a 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading – Majority vote (5))

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council approved the first reading of an amendment to the water system map. *Approved 8-0 (Recusal: Bissanti)*.

7. Bylaw Amendment 17-790: Amendment to Sewer System Map – 1<sup>st</sup> Reading (Motion to Move Bylaw Amendment 17-790 to a 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading – Majority vote (5))

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council approved the first reading of an amendment to the sewer system map. *Approved 8-0 (Recusal: Bissanti)*.
