 a. Resolution 18-18 (Corrected) Appropriation Loan Order (Borrowing Authorization (Motion to Approve Resolution 18-18 -Two-Thirds Majority Roll Call Vote (6))

ACTION: The Council approved resolution 18-18 (Corrected) Appropriation Loan Order (Borrowing Authorization) changing the word "designating" to "designing". *Approved 9-0*.

b. Resolution 18-44: Acceptance of Gift to the Council on Aging (Motion to Approve Resolution 18-44 - Majority Vote (5))

ACTION: The Council approved resolution 18-44 to accept a generous gift of \$18,633 from the Friends of Franklin Elders for the Council on Aging. *Approved 9-0*.

c. Resolution 18-46: Appropriation of Cable Funds in Support of PEG Service and Programming per MGL Ch. 44, §53F3/4 (Motion to Approve Resolution 18-46 - Majority Vote (5))

ACTION: The Council approved resolution 18-46 to Appropriate \$170,642.37 from the PEG Access and Cable Related Funds to be paid to Franklin Cable Access Corp. to operate the Cable Access Studio. *Approved 9-0*.

d. Resolution 18-47: Senior Citizen Property Tax Work-Off Abatement Program (Motion to Approve Resolution 18-47 - Majority Vote (5))

ACTION: The Council approved resolution 18-47 to increase the annual benefit for the Senior Citizen Property Tax Work-Off Abatement Program from \$1,000 per year to \$1,100 per year effective January 1, 2019. **Approved 9-0.**

e. Resolution 18-48: Acceptance of Gift to the Franklin Police Department (Motion to Approve Resolution 18-48 - Majority Vote (5))

ACTION: The Council approved resolution 18-48 to accept a generous gift of \$5,000 from the Digital Federal Credit Union to support the Police Department's efforts in providing programs that make a difference. **Approved 9-0.**

f. Resolution 18-49: Acceptance of Gift to the Franklin Fire Department (Motion to Approve Resolution 18-49 - Majority Vote (5))

ACTION: The Council approved resolution 18-49 to accept a generous gift of \$5,000 from the Digital Federal Credit Union to support the Fire Department's efforts in providing programs that make a difference. *Approved* 9-0.

g. Resolution 18-50: Acceptance of Gift to the Franklin Fire Department (Motion to Approve Resolution 18-50 - Majority Vote (5))

ACTION: The Council approved resolution 18-50 to accept a generous gift of \$150 from the Moms Club of Franklin for the Fire Department's efforts in keeping the community safe. *Approved 9-0*.

ACTION: The Council made a motion to move Zoning Bylaw Amendment 18-815 to a 2nd Reading. *Approved 9-0.*

 Zoning Bylaw Amendment 18-816: Changes to §185, Use Regulations Schedule Parts I and VII, Attachments 2 and 8 - 2nd Reading (Motion to Adopt Zoning Bylaw Amendment 18-816-Two-Thirds Majority Roll Call Vote (6))

ACTION: The Council adopted Zoning Bylaw Amendment 18-816 to amend the Poultry Use Regulations. *Approved 8-0. (Abstain: Hamblen)*

 Zoning Bylaw Amendment 18-818: Maximum Building Height Dimensional Regulations - 2nd Reading (Motion to Adopt Zoning Bylaw Amendment 18-818- Two-Thirds Majority Roll Call Vote (6))

ACTION: The Council tabled Zoning Bylaw Amendment 18-818 until the September 26th Town Council Meeting. *Approved 9-0.*

k. Zoning Bylaw 18-820: Zoning Map Changes on or near King Street, Summer Street, Lawrence Drive and Uncas Ave (Motion to Move Zoning Bylaw Amendment 18-820 for referral to the Planning Board- Majority Vote (5))

ACTION: The Council voted to amend Zoning Bylaw 18-820 by moving parcels 285-078-005 and 285-078-006 to Single Family IV from Residential V. *Approved: 9-0*.

ACTION: The Council made a motion to refer Zoning Bylaw Amendment 18-820, as amended, to the Planning Board. *Approved 9-0*.
