Guidelines for Use of the Library

In addition to the Town of Franklin's Facilities Use Guidelines

- 1. Parents/caregivers are responsible for the behavior and supervision of their children.
- 2. The Children's Room is specifically designed to serve the needs of young patrons 10 years and under. Children and their parents/caregivers can browse and select materials and use the Children's Room and technology. Tweens, teens and adults in the Children's Room are welcome to browse and select materials in the Children's Room as well. However, to preserve the Children's Room (for use by children, tweens, teens) adults not accompanied by children should use other rooms of the library for reading, studying, and other activities.
- 3. The Teen Room is dedicated space reserved for middle and high school students ages eleven to eighteen. Adults should use other rooms of the library for reading, studying and other activities.
- 4. Patrons may be asked to leave the library if their behavior or hygiene interferes with the ability of other patrons to use and/or enjoy the facility.
- 5. Running, pushing, shoving, talking loudly, noise that disturbs others, or other disruptive behavior will not be permitted.
- 6. Out of respect for other library patrons, conversations on cell phones and other hand held mobile devices must be taken in the hallway on the first floor, the courtyard or the parking lot.
- 7. All patrons must leave promptly at closing time.
