

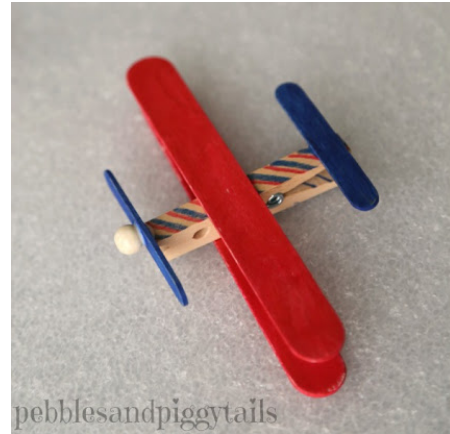
Take & Make Airplanes!

Materials Provided:

- 1 Clothes Pin
- 2 Large Craft Sticks
- 2 Mini Craft Sticks
- 1 Wooden Bead
- String

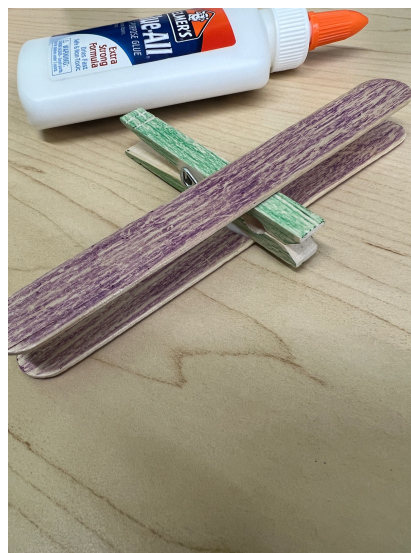
Additional Materials Needed:

- Markers or Paint
- Glue



Directions

- Color the craft sticks, clothes pin, and bead!
 - If you're using paint, be sure to allow the pieces to fully dry before moving on to the next step!
 - I used crayons, it worked, but paint or markers would probably be better.
- Place a dot of glue in the middle of the 2 large craft sticks. Place the sticks on the top and the bottom of the clothes pin.
- After the wings are dry, glue a mini craft stick on the top back edge of the clothes pin to make the plane's tail.



- While your waiting for the tail to dry, glue the wooden bead onto the middle of the second mini craft stick for the propeller and let it dry.
- Stand the plane up and glue the propeller on the top opening of the clothes pin. You may have to hold it in place for a bit until it dries. This is where the fast-drying glue would be awesome.
- OPTIONAL - Once everything is dry, you can use the fishing wire to hang your airplane so that it looks like it's flying!
