

Take & Make Bookmarks!

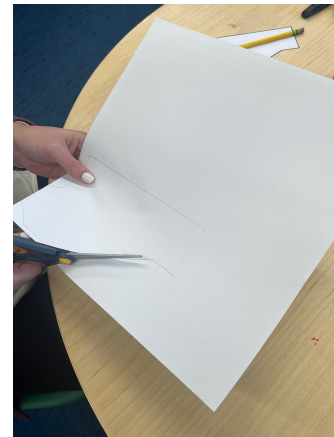
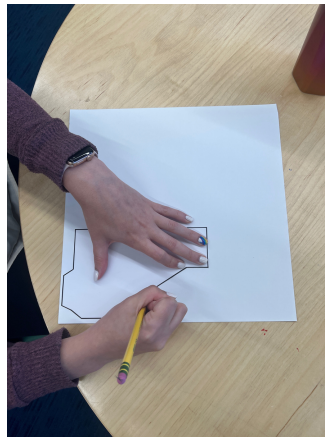
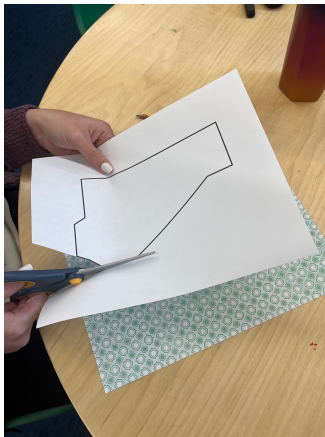
- Materials Provided:**
- 2 Scrapbook Pages
 - 1 Bookmark Template
 - 4 "What I've Read" Lists
 - 2 Tassels

- Additional Materials Needed:**
- Scissors
 - Glue
 - Hole Punch
 - Ruler (optional)



Directions

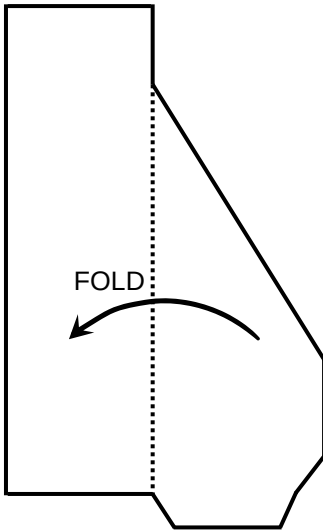
- Cut out the Bookmark Template, then trace the design onto the back of the scrapbook paper.
- Next, cut out the bookmark design.



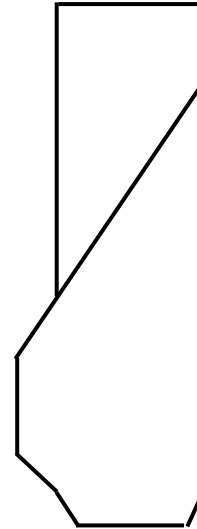
- Keeping the back of the scrapbook paper (the white side) faced up, you want to begin folding.
- You can use a ruler to help get a nice crease, but it's not necessary.

- First Fold:

BEFORE

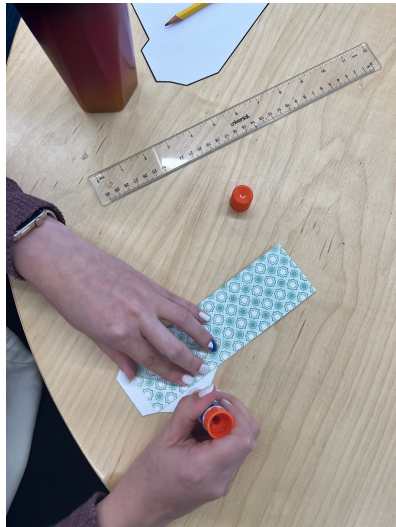
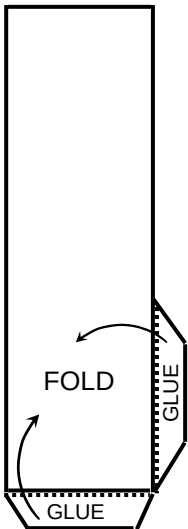

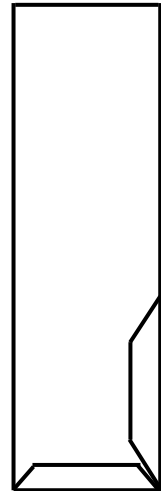


- Now flip your bookmark over so the patterned side is faced up.
- Add glue to the white tabs and fold up and over.

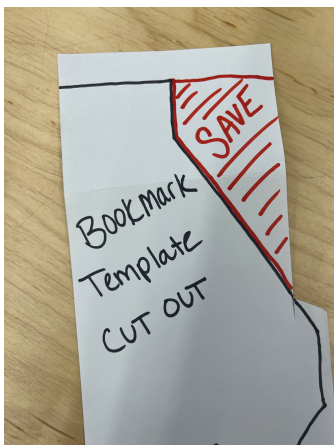

- Flip your bookmark over to the front. It should now look like:



- If you don't like all the white showing you can add more cutouts from the scrapbook paper. For example, when I cut out the initial shape, I saved the "not-quite-a-triangle" part, flipped it over and glued it in place so that I have a solid patterned front.



- Punch a hole in the top and add your tassel.
- Finally, cut out and slip in the "Books I've Read" list!
