

# Take & Make

## Lucky Leprechaun Hat!

### Materials Provided:

- Foam Block
- Green Paint
- Mod Podge
- Paint Brushes
- Foam Square
- Black Ribbon
- Gold Sticker
- Eye Hook
- Twine

### Additional Materials Needed:

- Glue
- Scissors

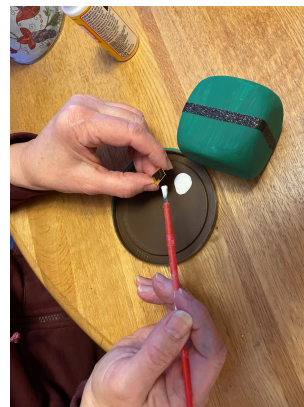


### Directions

- Using the large foam paint brush, paint the foam block green. It will take a few coats to get full coverage. Be sure to allow the paint to dry completely in between coats.

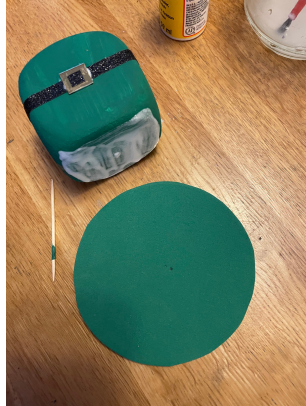
The small paint brush in your kit will be helpful when gluing the smaller pieces in the next few steps.

- Once the paint is dry, glue the black ribbon around the center of the block to create the hat band. **SAVE THE EXCESS RIBBON.**
- Trim the gold sticker into a smaller square that will fit more proportionally to the hat band.
- Cut a small piece from the remaining ribbon and glue to the center of your gold square. This will create a “buckle” for you hate band.
- Next, adhere the gold square to the center of the hat band. I would suggest gluing it, even though it’s a sticker.



Next, we're going to work on the brim of the hat.

- Take the foam square and either cut it into a circle or leave it as a square. If you leave it as a square, you might need to trim it so it fits better with the size of the block.
- Once you're happy with the shape and size of the foam sheet, you can glue it to the bottom of the block.
- Allow the glue to dry completely.



- If you want to hang your lucky hat, twist the eye hook into the top of the hat.
- Thread the two ends of the twine through the hook then back through the loop of twine to create a simple knot.
- Tie the ends of the twine together and hang!
