Take & Make April Showers!

Materials Provided:

- Paper Plate
- Yellow & Orange Cardstock
- Streamers
- Cotton Balls
- Yarn

Additional Materials Needed:

- Paint, Crayons, or Markers
- Scissors
- Glue
- Tape



Directions

- Cut your plate in half (or a little more than half) and then color it yellow.
- Then cut the yellow and orange paper into triangles. I needed a total of 10 triangles, but it will depend on how you cut the plate and what sizes the triangles are.





- Once the plate is dry (if you painted it), you can attach the triangles to make the sunrays!
 - I taped the triangles to the back of the plate, but you could also glue them.
- Next you can tape the piece of yarn to the back of the plate too!





- The 3 streamers provided are approximately 36-inches long (3 ft.). You want to cut them into small pieces, so that they're each about a foot long.
 - In the end, you should have 9 pieces of streamers in 3 colors.
- Tape (or glue) the streamers onto the front of the plate. In the sample, I only used 6 pieces of the streamer, but I would suggest layering all the pieces you have!
- Next take the cotton balls and glue them directly on top of where you attached the streamers to the plate.





• Lastly, you can trim the streamers into smaller strips to look more like rain!
