

Take & Make

Rainbow Tambourine!

Materials Provided:

- Paper Plate
- 6 Gold Bells
- Red Ribbon
- Cotton Balls
- Clothes Pins

Additional Materials Needed:

- Markers/Paint
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Glue
- Hole Punch



Directions

- Start by coloring or painting the back side of the paper plate. You can choose to any color you want or do a rainbow like in the pictures!
 - If you use paint, wait for the plate to dry completely before moving on to the next step.
- Fold your paper plate in half and use a pencil to mark where you want to place the 6 bells around the arc of the tambourine.



- Use a hole punch to punch through your pencil marks. Make sure both sides of the plate are lined up and punched through.



- Take the red ribbon and cut it into 6 smaller pieces.
- Thread them through the bells and then tie them through the holes of the paper plate. Don't make them too tight as they'll need to be loose to jingle!
 - Make sure you tie the ribbon through the holes on both sides of the plate.



- To make the tambourine nice and plump and soft, you can stuff the inside with some cotton balls.
- Finish off your tambourine by gluing the edges of the plate together. Clothes pins can be used to hold it in place while it dries.
