Take & Make Rainbow Twirler!

Materials Provided:

- Paper Plate
- Yarn
- Green Cardstock Hearts

Additional Materials Needed:

- Paint and Paint Brush
- Scissors
- Glue
- Tape or a Hole Punch



Directions

- Paint both sides of the paper plate in rainbow stripes. You could also use markers or crayons, but paint works best.
- Once the paint is dry, start from the outside of the plate and cut a spiral all the way to the middle. The thinner the bands the longer your spiral will be.





- Tape both ends of the yarn to the center of the plate. Now you have a loop so you can hang your finished twirler!
 - If you have a hole puncher, you could also punch a hole in the very center of the plate, thread the yarn through the hole and tie the ends together.



- To make the shamrock decorations cut out the green cardstock hearts.
- Glue the points of three hearts together to make a little shamrock.
 - There are enough hearts to make 6 shamrocks, but feel free to make more with your own green paper (or white paper colored green!)
- Lastly, glue the shamrocks onto the twirler.





Now hang it up and watch it twirl!
