

Take & Make Snow Globes!



Materials Provided:

- Snow Globe Template
- 7-inch Clear Plastic Plate
- Black Construction Paper
- Foam Craft Snow

Additional Materials Needed:

- Glue
- Scissors
- Crayons
- Watercolor Paints (Optional)

Directions:

- Draw a picture on the snow globe template. Some fun ideas include:
 - Your favorite winter activity
 - An outdoor winter scene
 - Favorite holiday tradition
- Color in their picture with crayons.
- OPTIONAL: Paint over their picture with watercolor paint.
 - Using crayons or oil pastels and watercolors together is a beautiful art technique called watercolor resist. It's fun to watch white crayons resist the watercolor paint!
- When the paint is dry, cut out both parts of the snow globe.
- Use the snow globe base as a template to trace it onto black paper and then cut.
- Glue the black snow globe base to the back of the snow globe.
- Carefully pour the foam snow onto the middle of the picture.
- Last, glue the plastic plate to the snow globe. Leave the snow globe lying flat until the glue dries to prevent the foam balls from moving around and adhering to the sides of the plate.
