

# Take & Make

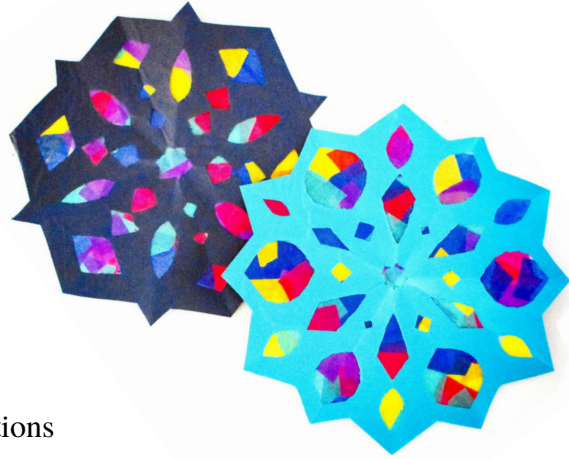
## Snowflake Sun Catcher!

### Materials Provided:

- Blue Construction Paper
- 2 Sheets of Contact Paper
- Assorted Tissue Paper

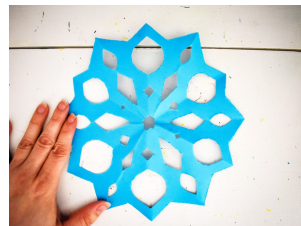
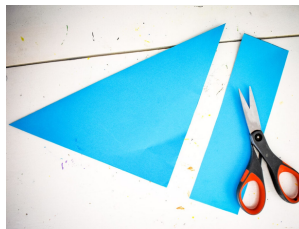
### Additional Materials Needed:

- Scissors
- Hole Punch (Optional)
- String (Optional)

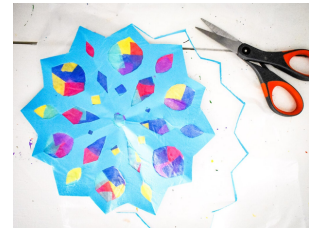


### Directions

- Begin by making your snowflake.
  - Fold one corner of the blue paper into a triangle and cut the excess strip.
  - Fold over into another triangle.
  - Now, fold one side over to a point then repeat with the other side.
  - Cut the top.
    - You'll need to cut a little more off the top than just the points so that the snowflake fits on the provided contact paper. I tried to mark in the photo below where best to cut.
  - From here, begin cutting patterns into the edges of the paper. All snowflakes are unique so make yours however you want.
- Once cut, unfold the paper to see your design.



- Remove the backing from one piece of the contact paper.
- Press the snowflake down onto the sticky side.
- Next, pick out the colors of tissue paper you want to use to decorate your Snowflake and cut into a bunch of small squares.
- Press the tissue paper into the open spaces of the snowflake.
- Once finished applying the tissue paper, take the second piece of contact paper, peel off the backing and place (sticky side down) over the tissue paper sealing everything in place.
- Trim the excess contact paper from around the snowflake, leaving a small border so that the seal doesn't break.
  - Make sure your scissors are clean or they may stick, making it difficult to cut.



**OPTIONAL:**

- You can use a hole punch to make a hole in the snowflake and then add a piece of string to make hanging the snowflake in the window easier.
