

# Take & Make

## Terracotta Wind Chimes!



### Materials Provided:

- 1.5 Inch Pot
- 2.5 Inch Pot
- 1 Jingle Bell
- 36 Inches of Twine
- 4 Beads
- Plastic "Beading" Needle
- Mod Podge & Paint Brush

### Additional Materials Needed:

- Markers or Paint
- Ruler

### Directions:

- Start by painting or coloring your flower pots however you wish! Allow them to dry completely. Then cover with a coat or two of Mod Podge to help protect from the outdoor elements.
- Take your twine and fold it in half, then slide the loop end through the hanger loop on the jingle bell.
- Thread the cut ends of twine through the loop that has already been strung through the bell and pull the twine up nice and tight.
- Measure your twine starting from the bell. You'll want to make a knot at about the 1.25 inch mark.
  - When you make your knots, I suggest making a double knot but make sure you make the second knot right on top of the first, not above or below.
- Slide 1-2 bead(s) down onto the knot.
- Next you want to thread the ends of the twine up through the smallest pot. *This part can be tricky but the beading needle can help your thread the twine*
- Measure 1 to 1.5 inches up the twine and repeat your double knot and adding 1-2 bead(s).
- Thread the ends of the twine up through the larger pot.
- Make a nice hanging loop above the top pot and there you have it!
